Parent Guidelines and Code of Ethics

PARENT GUIDELINES:

Parents are expected to abide by the following list of guidelines and expectations:

- 1) Read, sign and abide by the Code of Ethics (see below)
- 2) Read and sign the Player Liability Waiver and the Uniform Agreement.
- 3) Pay all JBA fees (uniforms will be distributed after collection of fee)
- 4) Register player for Community Ed. team (5th & 6th grade) or School Conference Team (7th & 8th grade) through the Community Education office. All players must fully participate on these teams in order to play on a JBA team.
- 5) Attend pre-season parent meeting.
- 6) Assist son or daughter in getting to practice and games on time. Pick up your player from practices and games promptly.
- 7) Basketball is a team sport. It is important that all players be in attendance at both practices and games. Coaches must be contacted in the event that your son or daughter is unable to attend due to illness, or to a religious, school or family commitment. Unexcused absences may result in loss of playing time.
- 8) Ensure that proper care is taken with the JBA uniforms. Uniforms should be machine washed and line dried. Uniforms are to be worn only for games and scrimmages. Uniforms can actually be used for practices at the request of the coach. Uniforms should NOT be worn to school, to school events (including basketball games), or to Community Ed/School Conference Team games.
- 9) Participate in the selection of a parent representative from your son's or daughter's team for the JBA Parent Advisory Board.

PARENT CODE OF ETHICS

- 1) I will provide positive support and encouragement for all children participating in youth sports by following this code of ethics.
- 2) I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
- 3) I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
- 4) I will require that my child play in a safe and healthy environment
- 5) I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
- 6) I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco-free sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from use at all youth sports events.
- 7) I will remember that the game is for children and not for adults.
- 8) I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- 9) I will be respectful of the coach's job and will not coach my son or daughter during the contest.
- 10) I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child and I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience within my personal constraints by being a respectful fan.
